TEAM BUILDING:

Gold Piece Allowance 1,200,000 for selecting players, re rolls, side line staff and purchase of permitted inducements.

PERMITTED INDUCEMENTS:

1. Star players are only permitted for the following Tier 3 Teams-

Goblin

Halfling

Snotling

Ogre

These teams may only include one star player, and only after a full 11 regular team players have been rostered.

2. Other permitted inducements are-

Bloodweiser Kegs

Bribes

Halfling Master Chefs

All permitted inducements must be purchased before the tournament, out of the 1,200,000 gold piece allowance.

ADDITIONAL SKILLS:

Once your team is fully purchased, you may distribute additional skills amongst your players. A coach can select either

8 Primary Skills OR

5 Primary Skills and 2 Secondary Skills

A maximum of 2 skills can be stacked onto the same player (including both Secondary skills if you wish)

Characteristic increases are not permitted.

SCORING:

Games will be organised using the Swiss Style with-

- 2 Points for a Win
- 1 Point for a Draw
- 0 Points for a Loss

- 1. Net Touchdowns
- 2. Net Casualties
