The phrases used in the rulebook and the lists differ slightly, and the outcome can be interpreted differently according to which book one uses.

For the competition, each list has been allocated a 'nation'. This is in column F in the above. Some of these are somewhat broad and have been applied for a combination of history and/or game play. Any game between armies in the same 'nation' can count as a 'civil war' regardless of whether the armies are listed as enemies.

The main impacts are:
All allies could potentially change sides (including regular allies of whatever origin) so any allied baggage **may not** be allocated to army baggage.

If an ally is unreliable, then it has the potential to change sides as in the rules.

One exception is the Serbian contingent in an Ottoman army will count as an ally but only if lighting an army in the same nation group. It will still cost as a SG (since it will not become unreliable against most other armies) and its baggage is capable of being in army baggage.
